ARTICLE XVI-WORK RULES

TRANSFER CREWS-DOUBLES

- A. Rear portion of trains from Gibson will be made ready on one track coupled. Transfer crew will couple up head end and double over. This will also apply at Michigan Avenue.
- B. Transfer crews from the west who have cars to deliver at points beyond Gibson will make a straight set out at Gibson the same as at any other intermediate point.

This agreement becomes effective at 12:01 a. m. on Th ursday, April 1, 1943, and shall continue in effect until changed as provided herein. If either party to this agreement desires to revise, modify, or abrogate any of its provisions, thirty (30) days' written advance notice containing the proposed changes shall be given and conference shall be held before the expiration of said notice unless another date is mutually agreed upon.
