5. NORPAUL YARD:

MODIFIED 1988 AGREEMENT ARTICLE XVI-WORK RULES: DOUBLES A. Trains from Norpaul will make up on one track coupled, but if one track will not hold the train transfer crew will make one double.

B. Transfer crews taking trains originating at Bensenville will make a

straight pick up at Norpaul the same as at any other intermediate point.

- C. Westward crews setting off or yarding trains at Norpaul will place cars on one track provided one track will hold the entire train or set out;
 - otherwise, they will make doubles necessary to dispose of their train or set out.
